

- (3) Except as provided in this bylaw, it is not necessary to give notice of an adjournment or of the business to be conducted at an adjourned general meeting.
35. A resolution proposed at a meeting need not be seconded, and the chair of a meeting may move or propose a resolution. In the case of a tie vote, a second vote is held, with the President not voting.
36. A Member in good standing present at a meeting of Members is entitled to one vote. Voting is by show of hands or by ballot if provided. Voting by proxy is permitted for out-of-town members. An electronic (ie: e-mail) vote must be sent to a member of the executive as proof of the proxy vote by an out-of-town member.
37. A corporate Member may vote by its authorized representative, who is entitled to speak and vote, and in all other respects exercise the rights of a Member, and that representative must be considered as a Member for all purposes with respect to a meeting of the Association.

MEMBERSHIP

38. Membership is open to anyone with an interest in the activities of the Association. **Ownership of a PT Cruiser is not a membership requirement.**
39. Individual members must pay an annual membership fee determined by the Association in order to vote and participate in the full range of chapter activities.
40. Members may belong to other car or PT Cruiser clubs that do not conflict with the interests of the Association. Family members may be affiliate members as the club deems appropriate.
41. The privileges of affiliate members are determined by the Association.
42. Honorary memberships are assigned by either the Association to individuals with a special affiliation to the club (e.g., national distributor, major sponsor, etc.). Honorary members do not pay dues, cannot vote or hold office, but can otherwise participate in activities.
43. Lifetime memberships are assigned by the Executive to recognize extraordinarily active and sustained members who deserve special recognition for their work on behalf of the Association. Lifetime members have full membership privileges but do not pay dues.
44. The Association should strive to use electronic and other media to make Club members from adjacent areas aware of Club activities.
