

45. Every Member must uphold the constitution and comply with these bylaws.
46. A person ceases to be a Member of the Association:
 - a. by delivering his or her resignation in writing to the Secretary of the Association or by mailing or delivering it to the address of the Association,
 - b. on his or her death or, in the case of a corporation, on dissolution,
 - c. on being expelled, or
 - d. on having been a Member not in good standing for one month.
47. Expulsion:
 - a. A Member may be expelled by a special resolution of the Members passed at a general meeting.
 - b. The notice of special resolution for expulsion must be accompanied by a brief statement of the reasons for the proposed expulsion.
 - c. The person who is the subject of the proposed resolution for expulsion must be given an opportunity to be heard at the general meeting before the special resolution is put to a vote.
48. All Members are in good standing except a Member who has failed to pay his or her current annual Membership fee, or any other subscription or debt due and owing by the Member to the Association, and the Member is not in good standing so long as the debt remains unpaid.

EXECUTIVE

49. The President shall preside at all meetings of the members of the Association. He/she shall have such powers and duties as may be assigned to him/her by the club. The President shall in all cases be ex-officio member of all committees.
50. The Executive shall supervise and transact the day-to-day business of the Association, and in so doing, shall ensure that any actions taken by the Executive are in harmony with Association policies and objectives as determined by the members.
51. The day-to-day business of the Association shall be conducted by such persons as, from time to time, are employed by the Association.
52. The Executive shall have discretion on whether or not to appoint full or part-time staff members and to define such duties and remuneration of the staff with respect to the activities of the Association.
53. Executive meetings may be at the call of the President/Chairperson. Three (3) members of the Executive shall form a quorum. Executive meetings may be held by conference call or other electronic means.
54. All Executive meetings are open to Members except under extraordinary circumstances.
